The NSW Premier announced a lockdown effective from 6PM today.

Affected areas

All of Greater Sydney, including:

- the whole of the Sydney Metropolitan area
- the Blue Mountains
- the Central Coast
- Wollongong

The lockdown will continue until Friday 9th July.

The ONLY reasons people can leave home

1. Shopping for food or other essential goods and services;
2. Medical care or compassionate needs including getting vaccinated;
3. Exercise outdoors;
4. **Essential** work or education, where you cannot work or study at home.

In her Press Conference the Premier Berejiklian said about education, "***given the school holidays, that obviously doesn't apply.***"

This means people CANNOT leave home for education.

Implications for tutoring

This means that tutoring **CANNOT** be done face-to-face if tuition providers are in the affected lockdown areas. The **ONLY** tutoring that can occur in the affected areas is **ONLINE TUTORING**.

ALL tutors, **members or non-members** are expected to follow the government's stay-at-home orders. We never want tutors to risk their clients' health or their own

health. Be calm, be cautious and be responsible. The ATA always advocates a precautionary approach to matters where consumers and/or tutors can be placed at risk.
